More than 150 photographs and facsimiles and accompanying texts relate how the peaceful revolution in the GDR did what no one had dared hope for and brought German reunification onto the agenda of German and international politics. The

exhibition examines both the developments within Germany and the diplomatic negotiations that made reunification on 3 October 1990 possible. The exhibition includes QR codes giving access to 18 video podcasts of people sharing their own memories (in German) of the eventful developments in 1990.
