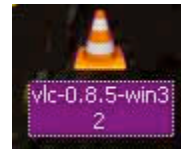


VLC Player

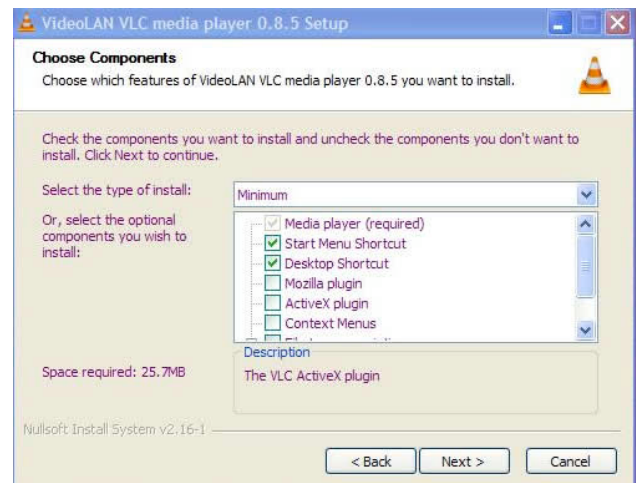
With VideoLAN (VLC) media player, you can get access to internet television stations from around the world at amazingly high quality.

To download the VLC media player, follow these easy steps:

1. Go to <http://videolan.org>.
2. Click “Download.”
3. Choose the correct platform (Windows/Mac).
4. Choose a package to download (we recommend self-extracting).
5. Save it to disk. Click OK.
6. Find the VLC icon on your desktop and double click it.
7. Choose a language.
8. Click “Next.”
9. Click “I Agree.”



10. We recommend choosing the minimum install.
If you are a user of Firefox, you might want to install the Mozilla/Firefox plugin (if you select this, then the heading under “type of install” will change to “Custom.”)
11. Click “Next.”
12. Click “Install.”
13. Click “Finish.”

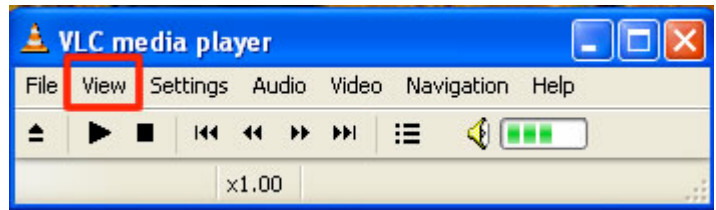


To view TV programs, follow these easy steps:

Note that you must be on campus to view TV programs.

1. Open the VLC media player.

2. Go to menu “View.”



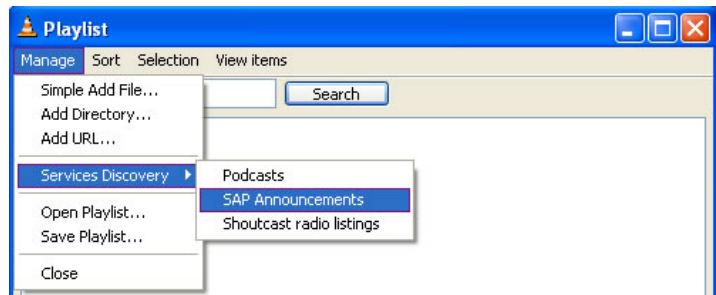
3. Choose “Playlist.”



4. Go to menu “Manage.”

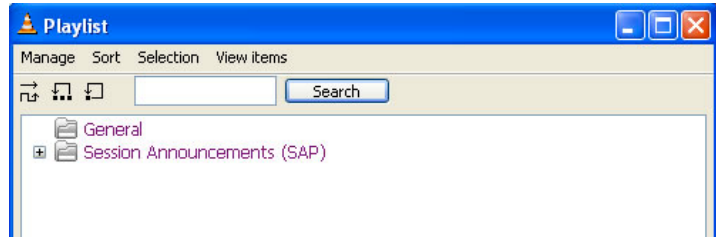
5. Choose “Services Discovery.”

6. Choose “SAP Announcements.”



7. Wait 30-60 seconds for the media player to identify broadcasts.

8. When the plus sign appears next to “Session Announcements,” click on the plus sign.



9. Click on the plus sign next to the folder “UCTV International.”

10. Double click on the broadcast that you wish to view.

11. To view the broadcast in full screen, right click on the screen and choose “Fullscreen.”

12. To go back to the player view, right click on the screen and uncheck “Fullscreen.”



Note: Any of the other broadcasts listed may also be viewed, but many are inactive.
